Putti Lal. Learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned S.C. agree that direction may be given to the respondents to consider the cases of these petitioners in the light of the said judgment of the Apex Court and those of the petitioners who are covered by the said decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court be regularized and minimum of pay scale excluding allowances be

also paid to them until their services are regularized. Let the necessary exercise be done within a period of six weeks.

All the aforesaid petitions are disposed of accordingly.
