

		<p>04-3-2003</p> <p>Present : Mr. Bahar U. Barqui, Advocate for the petitioner. Ms. Avnish Ahlawat, Advocate for respondent No.1.</p> <p><u>CM No. 11122/2002</u></p> <p>This is an application to bring on record the rejoinder by the petitioner.</p> <p>For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed and the rejoinder is taken on record, the right to which was closed on 30th September 2002.</p> <p><u>C.W.No. 2644/2001</u></p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he confines his relief to the right to sell cut flowers in the area notified by the respondent, authorities for the said purpose and does not press the other reliefs.</p> <p>A controversy is involved in this writ petition arising from the grievance of the petitioners, who sell cut flowers at Connaught Place in the notified areas for carrying on such business. It is not disputed that notifications were issued by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi dated 03.06.1997 and 12.03.1998 notifying certain areas where this business would be carried out. The petitioners are seeking relief of not being disturbed from the said areas in question.</p> <p>It cannot be disputed that till the said notifications are continued to have force of law, the members of the petitioners association have right to carry on business in the notified areas in accordance with the norms to carry on such business.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondents, however, state that it was proposed to withdraw the notification so far as Connaught Place area was concerned, to which objections have been filed. The said plea cannot be a defence on the part of</p>

		<p>the respondents as on date, since admittedly the notification has not been withdrawn.</p> <p>In case the notification is ultimately withdrawn, it will always be open to the petitioners to take out appropriate legal proceedings to challenge the same.</p> <p>In view thereof, it is directed that the petitioners be permitted to carry on the business of cut flowers in accordance with the norms and guidelines laid down for the said purpose in the areas notified for the same in pursuance to the aforesaid notifications till such notifications are continued to have force of law.</p> <p>The writ petitions stand disposed of with the aforesaid directions.</p> <p><u>CM No. 4567/2001</u></p> <p>No further orders are called for in this application in view of the disposal of the writ petition.</p> <p>The CM stands disposed of.</p> <p>Dasti to the parties.</p> <p>March 04, 2003 gg</p> <p> SANJAY KISHAN KAUL, J.</p>
