Without prejudice to the contentions raised in this Petition, the Petitioner has failed to qualify for the admission to Civil Services (Main Examination) 2003. The Petitioner was permitted to appear in the Examination pursuant to Interim Orders passed by this Court. Out of a total marks of 450 the Petitioner has obtained 243 marks. I have been shown the cut-off marks. Mr. R.N. Juneja, Under Secretary, U.P.S.C. requests that it be kept confidential. As this issue has not been raised in the present Petition, I shall accede to the request although, prima facie, I find that there is no reason for keeping it confidential.

In these circumstances I do not consider it appropriate exercising the extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
