I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner may be allowed to make a detailed representation within a period of 10 days to respondent No.1 raising all his grievances and in turn respondent No 1 may be directed to decide his representation within a period of 30 days.

The main grievance of the petitioner is that he was employed in the Municipal Council of Ambikapur and thereafter he was transferred from Ambikapur to Surajpur in the year 1987. He was again transferred to Municipal Council, Ambikapur in the year 1992 and at that time he was working as U.D.C.. During this period persons junior to him working in the Municipal Council, Ambikapur were promoted and he has challenged the same in this writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since very short time is left in the retirement of the petitioner, he may be allowed to make a detailed representation to respondent No.1 to which the learned counsel for respondents have no objection.
