Counsel for the petitioners submitted that petitioners retiral dues are not settled in accordance with the pay scale which was applicable to them. He prays that in similar matter bearing W.P.(S) No. 2072/2004, orders have been passed by the High Court of Madhya Pradesh on 13-4-2004. Counsel prays for similar order in this case also. Counsel for the respondents submitted that relying on the statement of the counsel for the petitioners made at the Bar, similar orders may be passed. Having thus considered and relying on the statement made by counsel for the petitioners at the Bar, it is directed that the representation filed by the petitioners as contained in Annexure P-10, which has been forwarded to the State, shall be decided within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of this order. If the petitioners are held entitled, they shall be paid interest at the rate of 6% which would be restricted for a period of three years only.
