Therefore the same is dismissed.</p> <p>The suit which was dismissed for default has been restored by the trial Court after accepting the reasons given by the plaintiffs for their non-appearance. The trial Court having exercised its jurisdiction ^{and} passed the impugned order, this Court shall not interfere. However, considering the fact that the proceedings are instituted in the year 1999, the trial Court shall dispose of firstly the application filed by the plaintiff to Sue Pauper and thereafter the suit. This exercise must be completed within a period of six months from the date of the receipt of this order.</p> <p>In view of this order, I.A.
