Application for urgent hearing is allowed.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter is exactly similar to the W.P.No.2707/2002 (Hariram Verma -vs- State of Chhattisgarh and others) where orders have been passed on 20.2.2003. Copy of that order has been filed as Annexure P-4 in this petition. He prays for similar orders in this petition also. Learned counsel for the State is not in a position to dispute the same.</p> <p>In view of the order dated 24.4.2001 passed in W.P.No.558/2001 (Zahirulla Khan and another -vs- State of Chhattisgarh & others), all the aspects contained in the present petition can be examined by the competent authority at the time of consideration. In the result, this petition is disposed of with the direction that the petitioner be given requisite form for enrolment and the same be examined on merit by the competent authority keeping in view the judgment rendered by M.P.High Court in W.P.No.287 of 1990 decided on 6.5.1997. The petitioner should enclose a copy of that order with the form while submitting the forms for enrolment.</p> <p>Consequently, M.W.P.682/2004 also stands disposed of.
