Bhatia, Panel Lawyer for the State.</p> <p>Application for urgent hearing is allowed.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The petitioner, who was serving as Secretary at Murpar Janpad Panchayat, was transferred to Janpad Panchayat, Marwahi on 2-6-2004. It is submitted that within two days of the receipt of the transfer order, the petitioner's wife has expired. It is further submitted that the petitioner is having two children aged about 11 years and 9 years respectively and is also having ailing parents of about 90-95 years old. It is also submitted that none has been posted in place of the petitioner.</p> <p>The matter was listed on 7-7-2004 and the time was granted to the State counsel to file reply. No reply till today has been filed.</p> <p>In the aforesaid view of the matter, a prayer is made that the petitioner may be allowed to submit detailed representation to the authorities concerned mentioning the fact of passing away of his wife, which shall be considered on its own merits in accordance with law.</p> <p>Having considered the facts and circumstances and the material on record, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of the respondents along with</p>

	<p>a copy of the petition and this order, within fifteen days, and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law ^{by reasoned order} as early as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of the representation. It is made clear that if any grievance still remains, the petitioner may avail the remedy available under the law.
