Verma, Additional Advocate General for the State.</p> <p>The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking relief that the certificate of the public notary be directed to be renewed for five years instead of three years.</p> <p>The case of the petitioner is that he is a practicing advocate and has been practicing at District Court, Bilaspur since 1980. The petitioner was appointed as Public Notary on 2-7-1994 vide Annexure-P/2. Certificate was renewed for a period of three years from 29-1-1998 vide Annexure-P/3 and thereafter again certificate was renewed on 1-7-2003 vide Annexure-P/4, whereas, as per the amended provision of Section 5(2) of the Act No.36 of 1999 the certificate ought to have been renewed for five years.</p> <p>I have heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>Learned counsel for respondents agrees that the certificate of the petitioner ought to have been renewed for five years as per the amended provisions.</p> <p>In the circumstances, the petitioner's petition deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to renew the petitioner's certificate for practicing as Notary for a period of five years instead of three years with effect from the original date from which he was entitled for renewal of the certificate.</p> <p>Parties are entitled for certified copy of this order.</p>
