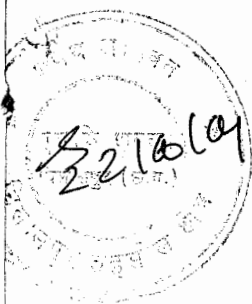

	<p><b>30-9-2004</b></p> <p>On a mention being made, this case is taken up. Shri Ratan Pusti, counsel for the petitioner. Shri V.V.S. Murthy, Dy. Adv. General, for the State. Application for urgent hearing is allowed. Heard.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter relates to transfer. He further submits that for the present the petitioner may be given an opportunity of filing the detailed representation before the competent authority of the respondents, which shall be considered on its own merits in accordance with law.</p> <p>Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of the respondents along with a copy of the petition and this order, within 10 days, and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of the representation.</p> <p>Counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been relieved and he be allowed to continue.</p> <p>It is directed that if the petitioner has not been relieved, he be allowed to continue till the representation is decided. It is made clear that if he has been relieved, this order will not entitle him to rejoin in the earlier place of posting.</p> <p>With the aforesaid observations, this petition stands disposed of. Consequently M.W.P.No. 2500/2004 also stands disposed of. Certified copy as per rules.</p>
