Rawat, counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Shri Shri Sanjay S.Agrawal, Government Advocate for the State/respondent.</p> <p>The petitioner has preferred this Writ petition contending that the respondent is not considering his application for regular permit for the route "Rajnandgaon to Durg via Ghatula, Bhaghera, Tedesara" and till the regular grant is made, the Road Transport Authority be directed to continue the temporary permit of the petitioner.</p> <p>The case of the petitioner is that he owns only one mini bus having registration No.CG-07-ZA-0110 and is plying the same on the temporary permit on the route "Rajnandgaon to Durg". He applied for the grant of regular permit and submitted the application on 22.06.2004 and also deposited the fees of Rs.1,000/-. A copy of the application is Annexure-P/2. The Road Transport Authority is duty bound to grant of regular permit under Section 72 read with Section 80 of the Motor Vehicle Act, but he is not considering his application.</p> <p>I have heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the State submits that to the extent of passing order on the application for regular permit is concerned, he has no objection.</p>
