Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter relates to transfer of the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has been transferred from Public Works Department, Durg to Bastar Division vide order dated 14/9/2004 (Annexure-P/1). He also submits that the transfer of the petitioner is made against the transfer policy. He also submits that for the present the petitioner may be given an opportunity of filing the detailed representation before the competent authority of the respondents, which shall be considered on its own merits in accordance with law.

Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of the respondents along with a copy of the petition and this order, within 15 days, and on such authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of the representation.

With the aforesaid observations, this petition stands disposed of.

Consequently M.W.P.No.4274/2004 also stands disposed of.
