Shri Manindra Shrivastava counsel for the petitioners. Shri N.K. Agrawal, Deputy Advocate General for the State/ respondents. Heard both the counsel. By this writ petition the petitioners have challenged the legality and propriety of the order dated 17.9.2004 passed by the appellate authority, the State Government, whereby the prayer for staying the effect and operation of the order passed by the Collector has been refused. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the appeal is still pending and only the stay application has been rejected, in the circumstances, if the appellate authority is directed to dispose of the appeal itself that will meet his requirement. To this submission, learned Deputy Advocate General has no objection. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the appellate authority i.e. the State Government is directed to dispose of the appeal as early as possible, but not later than first week of February, 2005. With the above direction, the petition stands disposed of. In view of this order, M.(W.) P.No.4605/2004 also stands disposed of, Parties are entitled for certified copy of this order.
