Towards the compliance of the Order of this Court, the appellants had deposited an amount of Rs. 21,70,956/-, which has been invested in a Fixed Deposit of a Nationalized Bank. By this application the applicants/respondents in First Appeal have prayed that the applicants be permitted to withdraw an amount of Rs. 5 lakhs from out of the amount deposited by the respondents/original appellants, so as to meet the expense of undergoing Angiography and by-pass surgery, if necessary. Accordingly, the applicants are allowed to withdraw the amount of Rs. 5 lakhs from out of the amount deposited by the respondents/original appellants on the following conditions:-

- 1. The applicants/original respondents shall furnish bank guarantee for 50% of the amount to be withdrawn and shall furnish adequate surety for the balance amount of 50% to the satisfaction of the Registrar.
- 2. The applicants/original respondents shall give an undertaking that they will refund the amount with interest as and when required to do so.

2. Miscellaneous Civil Application is, accordingly, allowed with no order as to costs.
