This Application has been made for directing the Appellants to deposit some further sums, which according to the Applicants, are payable as decretal amounts. This Court, after admitting the First Appeal, granted ad-interim relief subject to the deposit of the entire decretal amount with accrued interest and all other monetary benefits. This Order was passed on 25th July, 2002. The ad-interim relief granted was confirmed by an Order of November 29, 2002. While confirming that Order, this Court observed that the decretal amount is deposited as can be seen from the Office endorsements dated 9th October, 2002 and 16th October, 2002. This Court has also directed that the amount deposited should be invested in a Nationalized Bank. The prayer made today for directing the Appellants to deposit further amounts cannot be granted as this Court had already found that the decretal amount has been deposited in accordance with the Office endorsements. The contention that certain amounts are required to be deposited cannot be accepted as the decree itself has been stayed.
