This Civil Application has been filed, contending that there is a breach of the Order passed by this Court on 9th February, 2001. Therefore action is sought against the respondent under Order 39, Rule 2A of Civil Procedure Code.

The Order dated 9.2.2001 directs the Trial Court to decide whether temporary injunction should be given under Order 39, Rule 1 C.P.C. The Trial Court, after hearing both the sides on merits,
