This is an application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure at the behest of the Applicant who is one of the Accused facing trial punishable under Sections 302, 342, 364, 120-B r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The charge-sheet in the present case has been filed.

Bail is sought principally on the ground that the Applicant, who was in the family way when she was arrested has thereafter, on 17th May, 2004, delivered a child in the Goa Medical College. The Applicant has also annexed a certificate issued by Dr. Mrs. Pia Muriel Cardozo, Lecturer in the Department of Obstetric and Gynaec, dated 21st May, 2004 to that effect.

In the peculiar facts of the case, since the Applicant has delivered a child nearly about 15 days back, I am inclined to grant bail to the Applicant on this count.

Accordingly application allowed. The Applicant is directed to be released on bail on executing a PR Bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/with one surety in the like amount on the condition that the Applicant shall not leave the State of Goa without prior permission of the learned Judge assigned with deciding the sessions trial. The Applicant also not directly indirectly influence the witnesses or tamper with the prosecution case. Bail to be furnished before the
