1. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that out of the arrears payable

towards the hostel charges, a sum of Rs.23,221/- will be paid by him by Monday i.e. 3rd

January, 2005 by 5 p.m. The Warden of the University Hostel is directed to accept the

same in part payment in respect of the outstanding hostel dues. The balance amount of

Rs.7079/- will be paid by the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from today.

Petitioner is present in court and through his advocates gives an undertaking to the above

effect. On receipt of such payment, University is directed to issue all necessary mark

sheets and passing certificates as per order dated 6th November, 2004 passed by the Vice

Chancellor. Such Mark sheet and Passing Certificate will be issued within a period of

three days from the date of receipt of the entire balance payment. Petitioner further

undertakes to vacate the said hostel premises as soon as mark sheet and passing certificates

are handed over.

. In view of the aforesaid undertakings, University is directed not to disposss the

petitioner from the hostel premises for a period of eight weeks from today. It is made clear

that in the event of the petitioner 's default of either of the instalment i.e. by Monday, or

on expiry of eight weeks. University will be permitted to remove the petitioner from the hostel premises.
