The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The petitioner questions the suspension order dated 30.10.2003 issued by

the respondents 1 & 2 – Syndicate Bank.

As the petitioner has committed serious lapses, involving fraudulent aspects,

which are detrimental to the interest of the Bank, he was placed under suspension,

pending enquiry. As the suspension of the services of the petitioner is pending

enquiry, which is not as a measure of punishment, but it is only to facilitate the

enquiry and the respondents 1 & 2-bank is paying subsisting allowances to the

petitioner during the suspension period, according to the rules. Hence, I do not see

any illegality in placing the services of the petitioner under suspension and the said

order cannot be set aside.

The Writ Petition is, accordingly, dismissed. No costs. However, the respondents are

directed to complete the enquiry as expeditiously as possible within a period of six

months from the date of receipt of this order.
