Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the Affidavit filed herein the High Court may be pleased to Issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not considering the representations of the petitioner herein dt. 30.5.2003 and 19.10.2004 for his appointment as Secretary in the 4th respondent Society as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to law and consequently direct the respondents to appoint the petitioner forthwith as Secretary of 4th respondent Society.

The Court, the stage of admission, made the following:

ORDER:

The petitioner worked as a casual clerk in the fourth respondent-society and he was disengaged. The petitioner contends that he made representations to the fourth respondent on 30-05-2003 and 19-10-2004 to appoint him as Secretary of the fourth respondent-society. The grievance of the petitioner is that the fourth respondent so far did not pass any orders on his representations. Therefore, he approached this Court seeking a direction to the fourth respondent to consider his case for appointment as a Secretary in the existing vacancy.

In the light of the submissions made by the petitioner, the fourth respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on the representations of the petitioner dated 30-05-2003 and 19-10-2004 as per rules.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of. No costs.
