Pooja Banga, learned counsel for the respondent no.4 appeared.

Mr. Ranjit Saxena, learned counsel appearing on behalf respondent nos. 2 and 3 makes a statement on behalf of Uttaranchal Power Corporation that the electric supply shall be made only after construction of Ram Nagar Sub-Station, the work of which is in progress. He further says that the said construction would be over by 31.03.2005.

We only express that the power supply should be granted as soon as the Substation at Ramnagar is ready and in a position to effect the power supply, even if it is earlier to that date. With this, on the basis of the statement made, the urgency application, stay vacation application as well as writ petition are disposed of.
