## Hon'ble M.M. Ghildiyal, J

Heard Sri Alok Mehra, learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Standing Counsel who has accepted notices on behalf of all the respondents.

By means of this writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order 21.04.2000 and further have prayed to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to pay the due salary to the petitioner in the scale of Rs. 2550-3200 alongwith allowances regularly with other benefits.

Both the parties have agreed that the writ petition is covered by the judgment of this Court in w.p. no. 236 (S/S) 2000 Pooran Singh Vs. State of Uttaranchal and others, w.p. no. 1257 (S/S) 2001 Deewan Singh & others vs. State of U.P. and others and w.p. no. 2039 (S/S)2001 Kunwar Singh and others vs. State of U.P. and others decided on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2003.

Counsel for the petitioner has confined his prayer that the present writ petition may be decided in the same terms and conditions of the aforesaid judgment.

Consequently, the writ petition is finally disposed of in the terms of the judgment of this Court in w.p. no. 236 (S/S) 2000 Pooran Singh Vs. State of Uttaranchal and others, w.p. no. 1257 (S/S) 2001 Deewan Singh & others vs. State of U.P. and others and w.p. no. 2039 (S/S)2001 Kunwar Singh and others vs. State of U.P. and others decided on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2003.
