Division Bench of this Court in the case of Sukhdev Singh
Mehta vs. State of Uttaranchal and others in w.p. no. 860 (S/B)

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that
the case is covered by the aforesaid decision.

Learned counsel for the parties agreed that direction may
be given to the respondents to consider the case of the
petitioner in the light of the aforesaid judgment and if the case

given benefits thereof and his name be included in appropriate
place in the seniority list. Let the necessary exercise be done
within a period of six weeks from today.
