Mr. Sharad Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Sobhit Saharia i/b Mr. U.K. Uniyal, Senior Advocate, and Mr. N.C.Gupta, learned standing Counsel appeared.

Mr. Sharad sharma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner realizing that an order has been passed subsequently on 17.08.2004 after filing of this writ petition on 06.07.2004, and in view of the further stand taken by the Government that his case was also considered in the meeting dated 31.10.2003, seeks to withdraw this petition in order to enable the petitioner to challenge the order dated 17.08.2004 on the ground of non-application of mind and other available grounds. The petitioner is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty.

However, there shall be status quo in respect of the petitioner for seven days from today.

Petition, if filed, be brought before this Court immediately.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly as withdrawn.
