## + WP (C) 7533/2002

The petitioner has filed the present petition aggrieved by rejection of the case of the petitioner for allotment of a plot under the re-location scheme for polluting industries. The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner produced the relevant documents including sales tax registration certificate for the relevant period of time though under a different name and the explanation for the same is that, that was the prior name under which the business of the petitioner was being run

In the counter affidavit filed by the respondents it is not clear as to what is the appreciation of the documents furnished by the petitioner. Reference has been made to the income tax return of the year 1998 filed by the petitioner. I am of the considered view that these documents would not be of much relevance since what is to be seen is as to whether the petitioner was carrying on manufacturing activity prior to the cut-off date of 19 04 1996. It is in this respect that documents were required to be produced and appreciated by the respondent authorities.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, I consider it appropriate to direct the Commissioner (Industries) to examine the case of the petitioner afresh and take into consideration the documents in respect of the period prior to 19 04 1996

The petitioner should appear before the Director (Industries) on 07 06 2004 at 11 00 AM and the petitioner shall produce whatever documents they wish to produce to substantiate their claim of carrying on manufacturing activity prior to 19 04 1996. A personal hearing will be given on that date and the concerned authority shall pass a speaking order on the issue of appreciation of the documents
