Learned counsel for the respondent fairly states that this impugned letter cannot be said to be in compliance of the Order dated 09.09.2004 mentioned above and that in view of the fact that this impugned letter has been issued, the hearing will be granted to the petitioner at a higher level and the General Manager of the respondent will grant the hearing</p> <p>In view of the aforesaid, the impugned letter dated 22.11.2004 is quashed and the rule is made absolute leaving the parties to bear their own costs</p>
