		<p>In order to have the feel of the matter; an idea about the background in which this petition was filed and some litigation in respect of the property belonging to the said person, some orders were passed by us from time to time. Though certain documents have been filed in pursuance of the said orders but bearing in mind the fact that we are dealing with a writ petition for <i>habeas corpus</i>, we refrain from commenting on the said documents as also the rival submissions of learned counsel for the parties thereon, lest it may cause prejudice to any party in the pending civil litigation between the parties herein and a third party as well.</p> <p>Dinesh Kumar Hooda has been produced again and we have talked to him for some time. During the course of our talks we have found him in a better state of health as compared to ^{our} the last meeting with him. He is coherent while answering all our queries. He has clearly stated before us that he does not want to stay with his daughter, namely, the petitioner for some personal reasons and would like to stay with respondent No.5, namely, the sister.
