Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, and perused the impugned award.

It appears at page 2 of the impugned award that even according to the witness produced by the present petitioner, the workman had commenced working with the respondent in the year 1974, and in the last, he worked up to only 1992, and since 1976, all workmen were kept on daily wages basis after Serial No.18 in the seniority list.

It is on appreciating these circumstances that the learned Labour Court has found that the principle of "last come first go" has not been followed by the present petitioner, and the workman has been ordered to be reinstated, with continuity in service and seniority, but without back-wages.

I do not find any sufficient ground to interfere with the impugned award. The writ petition is, therefore, dismissed summarily.
