Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner has already filed appeal against rejection of his grant of mining lease. That appeal is said to be pending. Only grievance of the petitioner, in the moment is that, the incumbent of the office has not been conferred the powers, and therefore, he is not hearing the appeal, and in the meantime, the land is likely to be allotted to other persons.

Suffice it to say that the petitioner may approach the competent authority for the needful, and for protection of his rights. However, when the matter is already pending before the appellate authority, I am not inclined to entertain the present writ petition. The same is, therefore, dismissed summarily.
