Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, and perused the impugned orders.

All the three Courts have gone through the matter in detail, rather threadbare, and found that the appellant has failed to prove that the seller, Preetam Singh etc., has any right to sale the part of the land sold, as Preetam Singh etc. themselves filed a suit way-back in the year 1969, challenging the entry standing in the name of Nayab Singh etc., and that suit was withdrawn with the liberty to file fresh one. Thus, the land never belonged to the petitioners' predecessor, so as to confer any title or interest on the petitioner. In these circumstances, I do not find any sufficient ground to interfere with the impugned orders.

The writ petition is, therefore, dismissed summarily.
