


Wangdi, learned Advocate General at the very outset that the Department needs some time to take necessary approval of the Government for allotment of housing site to Mr. P. K. Rai, the present petitioner herein as this approval could not be obtained as the concerned Minister is on tour to Australia and New Zealand and he is expected to arrive Gangtok during the 3rd week of August, 2005.
