Advocate for the State.</p> <p>The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.</p> <p>The case of the petitioner is that he was appointed as Public Notary for Civil District Dhamtari on 10.12.1990 and thereafter, his certificate to practice as Public Notary has been renewed from time to time and there is no complaint against the petitioner while he was working as Public Notary. On 1.10.1999 the petitioner has applied for renewal of his certificate but same was not renewed, then again in the year 2002 the petitioner has applied for renewal of his certificate but again it was refused and the petitioner was communicated the said refusal on 15.12.2003 vide Annexure P-1 issued from the office of the District & Sessions Judge, Raipur.</p> <p>Counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the decision of this Court dated 24.3.2005 passed in W.P.No.3247/03 between Chandra Prakash Sharma Vs. State of C.G. & others & other connected matters and respondent ought to have renewed the certificate of the petitioner to practice as Public Notary, which is not disputed by learned Govt. Advocate for the State.</p>
