Government Advocate for the State of Chhattisgarh.</p> <p><b>I.A.No. 7053 of 2005</b></p> <p>This is an application for urgent hearing.</p> <p>The application stands disposed of.</p> <p>The petitioner has filed earlier writ petition W.P.No.2339 of 2005 challenging the order dated 31.12.1998 passed by Joint Director, Panchayat and Social Welfare Services, Bilaspur Division, Bilaspur. The petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 15.06.2005, with liberty to file an appeal before the concerned authority in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an appeal was sent to through proper channel i.e. it was sent by Registered post. As indicated in the envelop annexed herewith at page 24, the envelop indicates first on 16.07.2005 that "lene se inkar kiya" and thereafter on 21.07.2005 "absent". It is not clear as to whether appeal was sent by any other method or not. It is further not clear, as alleged by the petitioner that the appellate authority declined to accept the appeal, from the postal remark.</p> <p>In view of earlier order dated 15.06.2005 passed by this Court, this petition stands dismissed.</p>
