Advocate for the State/ respondents.</p> <p>Heard both the counsel.</p> <p>The petitioner has preferred this writ petition with a grievance that respondent No.3 is not deciding the application of the petitioner for grant of Bhoomiswami right.</p> <p>The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner is a Kotwar and the forefather of the petitioner namely Paramsukh was appointed as Kotwar by the then Malgujar. The land bearing Khasra Nos.296/1, 330/2, 429, 438, 466, and 582, total area 7.74 acres was given to him. The land in question was held by him prior to abolition of Proprietary (Estate, Mahal and Alienated land) Rights Act 1950, and as per the Act the ancestors of the petitioner had Bhoomiswami right on the land and the said land is in continuous possession of the petitioner, therefore, he is entitled for Bhoomiswami right being a Kotwar.</p> <p>Counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondent No.3 be directed to decide the case of the petitioner regarding Bhoomiswami right to which counsel for respondents has no objection.</p> | |
