The petitioner, who was working on the post of Assistant Teacher in Primary School, Palari, was transferred from Palari to Middle School, Dharsiwa vide order dated 11.8.2004 (Annexure P-5) on the ground of husband and wife to be kept at the same place because the husband of the petitioner was working at Dharsiwa. Later on, the effect and operation of this order was stayed by another order dated 19.8.2004 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioner was again directed to return back to Primary School, Palari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now the husband of the petitioner has been transferred from Dharsiwa to Raipur, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in going to Dharsiwa and for the time being she will be happy at Palari and in any case she would like to go to Raipur so that she may live alongwith her husband at Raipur.

Since it is a subsequent development, therefore, for the present learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed
