It is noted that the petitioner has not submitted any representation before the concerned competent authorities.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner may be directed to make a representation before the concerned competent authorities and if such representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided.</p> <p>Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of respondents alongwith a copy of the petition and this order within a period of 15 days from today and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation.
