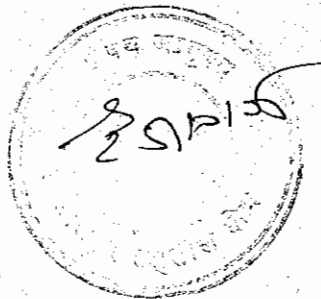

	<p>30-11-2005</p> <p>Shri Yogendra Chaturvedi, Advocate for the petitioner. Shri Sandeep Dubey, Govt. Advocate for the State on advance copy. I.A. No. 9440/2005 for urgent hearing is allowed. Heard. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter relates to regularization of the petitioner. He further submits that in similar matter bearing W.P. No. 3847/2004, orders have been passed by this Court on 28-10-2004. He prays that similar orders may be passed in this case also. Prayer is not opposed by the State Counsel. Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of respondents along with a copy of the petition and this order within a months and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within three months from the date of receipt of the representation. It is made clear that if any grievance still remains, the petitioner may avail the remedy available under the law. With the aforesaid observations, this petition stands disposed of.
