	<p><u>28/10/2005</u></p> <p>Shri Ajit Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner. Shri Akhil Agrawal, Panel Lawyer for the State. Heard on admission.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as a Range Officer at Rengakhar, District Kabirdham. By an order dated 3/9/2005, the respondent No.4 was transferred from Mahasamund to Rengakhar and the petitioner was not transferred from Rengakhar to any other place. When such situation arose, the petitioner filed a Writ Petition bearing No.4465/2005. This Writ Petition came up for hearing before this court on 23/9/2005 and this Court while dismissing the Writ Petition observed that the petitioner cannot complain of infringement of any legal or statutory right when no order adverse to him had been passed. The petitioner may very well continue till some order is passed transferring him from the present place of posting to any other place.</p> <p>Learned counsel submits that thereafter, the impugned order has been passed on 20/10/2005 and it has been directed that the new incumbent shall be given the charge of the Office and the petitioner shall be kept as the Officer on Special Duty.</p> <p>I do not find any infringement in the aforesaid action taken by the State.</p> <p>The petition has no merit, and the same is dismissed.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Sd/- Sunil Kumar Sinha Judge</p>
