No. 9354/2005 for urgent hearing is allowed.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been repatriated back to accommodate respondent no. 5. It is contended that this could not have been done. He further submits that he submitted a representation annexure P-5 to the Chief Minister and the said representation was directed to be decided as per Annexure P-6. He further submits that for the present, the petitioner may be given an opportunity to file a detailed representation raising his grievances.</p> <p>Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of respondents along with a copy of the petition and this order within 10 days and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within 4 weeks from the date of receipt of the representation. It is made clear that if any grievance still remains, the petitioner may avail the remedy available under the law.</p> <p>With the aforesaid observations, this petition stands disposed of. M.W.P.
