	<p>23-12-2005</p> <p>Shri H.S. Ahluwalia, Adv. for the petitioner. Shri Satish Gupta, Dy. G.A. for the State. Heard on I.A. NO. 10951/2005 for taking additional documents on record. The application is allowed. Documents are taken on record. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred by order dated 14-11-2005 during ban period. He further submits that for the present the petitioner may be given an opportunity of filing the detailed representation before the competent authority of the respondents, which shall be considered on its own merits in accordance with law. Having considered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in the opinion of this Court, ends of justice will be served if a direction is given to the petitioner to make a detailed representation raising his grievances before the competent authority of the respondents along with a copy of the petition and this order, within 2 weeks from today, and on such representation being filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall decide the same on its own merits in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within two months from the date of receipt of the representation. It is made clear that if the petitioner has not been relieved, he be allowed to continue till the representation is decided. With the aforesaid observations, this petition stands disposed of. Consequently M.W.P.No. 5143/2005, I.A.10950/2005 and I.A. No. 10952/2005 also stand disposed of. Certified copy as per rules.</p>
