Counsel submits that the record is lying with the General Administration Department. Learned counsel for the petitioners makes a limited prayer that presently the records of the said original application be called or transferred from the General Administration Department, at Raipur, as early as possible and the matter be disposed of in accordance with law. Counsel for the petitioners submits that since the S.A.T. has been abolished, there is no impediment in transferring the matter to this Court as the matters are to be transferred in a routine manner.</p> <p>State Counsel does not oppose the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners.</p> <p>The prayer is allowed.</p> <p>Let the records of O.A.
