

The main grievance of the petitioners is that the records of the original application No. 1717/91 filed before the State Administrative Tribunal, Jabalpur has not been received or transferred to this Court till date. Counsel submits that the record is lying with the General Administration Department. Learned counsel for the petitioners makes a limited prayer that presently the records of the said original application be called or transferred from the General Administration Department, at Raipur, as early as possible and the matter be disposed of in accordance with law.
