1. Heard the learned counsel for both the parties.

The Second appeal was dismissed and disposed of by Order dated 18th August, 2005, however, the respondent-Zilla Parishad was required to pay certain dues payable to the present applicant towards his terminal benefits and therefore, order dated 26th August, 2005 was passed to the effect that the Respondent - Zilla Parishad should pay the entire dues as per rules to the applicant within particular time,

failing which the Zilla Parishad was held to be liable to exemplary costs. Accordingly, today the statement is made on behalf of the Zilla Parishad that entire dues are paid by them to the applicant. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that though the applicant is satisfied in this regard, liberty should be left to him if any other payment is found due as per rules. In view of these directions the application stands disposed of on the basis of statement made by the advocate for the Zilla Parishad that all due payments are made to the applicant. However, liberty is given to the applicant to move the appropriate forum if any dues are yet to be found payable as per the rules.
