The applicant seeks anticipatory bail respect of C.R.Nos.(1) I-59 of 2003, (2)I-36 of 2005, (3) I-137 of 2003 and (4) I-167 of 2003 in respective applications. A similar order has been passed by this Court in Crim. Application Nos.8277 of 2005 and other companion applications on 23rd December, 2005. The applicant has been arrayed in several C.Rs because of his association with a company called Adhunik Griha Nirman. The applicant has already been granted anticipatory bail Crim.Application Nos. 8463 of 2005 and 8464 of 2005 in respect of identical charges in certain other C.Rs. The offences are registered under sections 406, 409, 420 read with sec.34 of I.P.C. In the circumstances the applicant is granted anticipatory bail in terms of prayer (a) of the application on the following terms and conditions.

- i) In the event of arrest of applicant in respect of CR No.I-59 of registered with Pali Station, Raigad, in respect of No.I-167 of 2003 registered with Vadgaon, Mawal Police Station, Pune, in respect of No.I-137 of CR 2003 registered with Khed, Pune Gramin Police Station, Pune and in respect of CR No.36 2005 registered with Mohpada, Rasayani Police Station, Raigad. applicant shall be released on bail in the sum of 30,000/- for each CR with two sureties in the like amount.
- ii) The applicant shall report to the Addl.S.P., Flying Squad, C.I.D.Pune between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. from 29th December, 2005 for a week and thereafter once a fortnight.

- iii) The applicant shall not leave the limits of Alibag without permission of the Investigating Officer except for reporting at the C.I.D.office.
