ORDER:

The petitioner is a construction company. It claims to have been awarded the contract, under Valmiki Ambedkar Awas Yojana scheme in Rangareddy Distict, at Ammuguda, Malkajgiri Municipality, for construction of 40 houses/flats, for weaker sections. It is being denied the allotment of work, on the ground that it is not registered with the first respondent Corporation. The petitioner claims to have made a representation, dated 16.8.2005, for allotment of balance of work, and complains that no action has been taken thereon.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Standing Counsel for respondents.

A perusal of the representation, dated 16.8.2005, submitted by the petitioner,

discloses that it narrated various developments that have taken place, ever since it

has been entrusted the work. Some part of the work appears to have been left

unexecuted. Explaining the reasons that resulted in such a situation, the petitioner

requested for entrustment of the balance of work. The question, as to whether the

petitioner deserves to be entrusted the balance of work, needs to be considered by

the respondents. This Court cannot express any opinion on the same. The

representation of the petitioner cannot be kept pending, indefinitely.

Therefore, the writ petition is disposed of, directing the first respondent to

pass appropriate orders on the representation, dated 16.8.2005, submitted by the

petitioner, within a period of four weeks, from the date of receipt of a copy of this

order. There shall be no order as to costs.
