## Hon'ble B.C. Kandpal, J.

The applicant has applied for bail in case crime no. 53 of 2004, U/Ss 342, 363, 372, 373, 376 and 366(A) I.P.C., Police Station – Rajpur, District –Dehradun.

Heard Sri Ram Ji Srivastava, learned counsel for the applicant, learned Addl. G.A. and perused the record.

The record shows that the F.I.R. in this case has been lodged after about 3-1/2 years. The applicant has filed photographs alongwith the bail application showing therein that the marriage between the prosecutrix and the applicant have already been taken place.

Learned Addl. G.A. could not controvert these facts specifically.

The applicant is in jail for the last more than 4 months and learned Addl. G.A. could not show any criminal history of the applicant.

Having considered aforesaid circumstances, I think it is just and proper to released the applicant on bail at this stage.

Let the applicant, Sushil Chaudhar be released on bail on executing personal bond and furnishing two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of C.J.M. concerned.
