Beriwal, Deputy Advocate General for the State, on advance copy.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was promoted to the post of Inspector vide order dated 8.3.2006. He refers to Annexure P/1. His grievance is that after issuance of the aforesaid promotion order the petitioner is not being relieved from his present place of posting for joining to the promotional post. Learned counsel further submits that a representation vide Annexure P/2 was given by the petitioner on 4.5.2006 but the same has not been considered so far. For the time being, learned counsel submits that this petition may be disposed of with a direction to the concerned authorities to decide the representation filed by the petitioner. This limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by learned counsel for the State. The same is allowed.</p> <p>It is directed that if the representation vide Annexure P/2, filed by the petitioner, has not been decided so far, the concerned authority shall dispose of the said representation as early as possible preferably within a period of 1 ½ months from the date of filing of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition, filed before this Court.</p> <p>In view of the foregoing, the petition stands finally disposed of.</p> <p>Certified copy as per rules.</p>
