1. The Family Court of Pune passed order under provisions of section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure directing the applicant to pay the sum of Rs.2,000/- and Rs.1,000/- to his wife and child respectively as maintenance in petition no. P/612/03.

The wife not being satisfied with this order filed Criminal Revision Application no. 48 of 2006 before this Court. This Court has enhanced the order to Rs.3,500/- and Rs.2,500/- respectively for mother and the child with costs of Rs.1,000/-. This order came to be passed on 23rd February 2006. By filing the present application, the applicant seeks stay of the execution before the Family Court.

2. Since the Revision was filed by the wife which has been partly granted, the order passed by this Court cannot be stayed for the present as prayed by the applicant. The applicant is however at liberty to move the Family Court for appropriate orders.

3. Liberty however given to move this Court again on reopening. No order for now.
