- 1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant.
- 2. The applicant is the sister-in-law of the complainant wife at whose behest offences punishable u/s.498A, 406, 323, 504 r/w sec.34 of the IPC have been registered. The matter has been almost investigated. The complaint was against the husband of the

complainant, mother-in-law, brother-in-law and the present applicant. The others have been arrested and admitted to regular bail.

- 3. The present applicant is the sister-in-law of the complainant. Her anticipatory bail is rejected by the Sessions Judge. This Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the applicant on condition that she co-operates with the investigation and appears in the police station whenever called.
- 3. She shall be released on executing P.R. bond of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount, in the event of her arrest.
