1. Heard the learned Counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.

2. The first application of the applicant was rejected on 08/03/2006. However, liberty was granted to the applicant to apply for bail again if the trial is not over within a period of six months. The applicant was arrested on 05/08/2005 and is in jail since then. The other co-accused have been released on bail after the application of the applicant was rejected by this Court. Trial is not likely to commence in the near future. Applicant has a fixed place of

residence. Admittedly, there are no criminal antecedents against the present applicant. Under these circumstances, in my view, the applicant is liable to be released on bail.

3. Applicant be released on bail in the sum of Rs 5000/- with two local sureties in the like amount. He shall attend Kalamboli Police Station twice in a month. The applicant shall not threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence.

4. Application is disposed of in the above terms.
